A Member seeking back-dated experience credits will need to contact the person responsible for the experience and have them apply for USRPTIA certification-points credits.

Applying for Coaching-Certification Credit for an Event

The *APPLICATION FOR USRPTIA COACHING-CERTIFICATE POINTS FOR A USRPT COACHING EXPERIENCE* form should be submitted to the Education Committee by the experience organizer when a course, clinic, or educational experience is planned and USRPTIA coaching-certification points are sought. No information should be omitted from the form.

The procedure for making an application is described under the *Coaching Certification* column at the link *Applying for Coaching Certification Credit for an Event* in the main directory table on the Home Page (<http://usrptia.org/>). The application form is presented as a fixed-space font so it may be copied and pasted into the body of an email or submitted as an email attachment. It is preferred that the form is embedded in the body of an email. This form is for use by a Member seeking either a certification-points allocation for a proposed or past USRPT-related experience. A Member of the Education Committee will advise the Member of the number of certification-points that can be attributed to the planned or past experience. It is highly likely that some applications will be evaluated as having no or insufficient relevance for USRPT to earn a certification-points recognition. This form should be convenient for the Member to submit a request.

For communications to the Education Committee, the form should be copied and pasted into an email. The information should be entered when the email document is open. The lines in the forms are only there to serve as a guide. A user can delete the lines as is deemed appropriate when completing a form as part of an email.

The completed form should be submitted via email to *education@usrptia.org*.
